WHITE WINES

1. Leopard's Leap Sauvignon Blanc 2008

An elegant, well structured wine with hints of lime and grapefruit with a light green pepper mouth-feel.

Sauvignon Blanc

2. Elgin Vintners Sauvignon Blanc 2008

Vibrant and fresh, displaying layers of tropical fruit and hints of lime, green pepper and asparagus.

3. Spice Route Sauvignon Blanc 2009

Mineral, chalky nose with hints of gooseberry and classic cool climate aromas. Good acid and fruit balance, with lively fruit. Long fresh finish.

4. Hartenberg Sauvignon Blanc 2007

Aromas of passion fruit and white asparagus on the nose, with a vibrant freshness, fullness and purity on the palate. Passion fruit and white asparagus gives this crisp white a long and full finish.

5. Mulderbosch Sauvignon Blanc 2007

Pale straw with a lively green colour. A tropical fruit punch nose, packed with granadilla, guava, fig, gooseberry and green pepper – yet maintaining its complex character of grassiness and nettle.

6. Southern Right Sauvignon Blanc 2008

This Sauvignon Blanc shows marked fruit aromatics while maintaining a seasoned balance between old world minerality and length with new world palate coverage and body.

7. Springfield Sauvignon Blanc 2008

This single vineyard originates from the rockiest soil on the Springfield estate, with resultant struggling vines and huge concentration. A dramatic wine full of ripe red peppers and passion fruit.

Semillon

8. Fairview Oom Pagel Semillion 2006

Opulent, with a fantastic texture, concentrated lemon, citrus blossom and green fig aromas, which follow through to the palate. Rounds off with spicy clove and vanilla oak flavours. Named after one of the much loved workers that lived and died on the farm who was affectionately called Oom (Uncle) Pagel.

9. Constantia Uitsig Semillon Reserve 2003

This excellent flagship wine spends 10 months in French oak barrels. Quite an assertive nose with some oak notes. The palate is crisp and fresh.

Chardonnay

10. Darling Cellars Chardonnay "Quercus Gold" 2009

Citrus, orange blossoms and pineapple are the fruit flavours you'll find on this little gem of a lightly wooded Chardonnay. A clean, soft mouth-feel with lower acidity and pear on the palate.

11. Jordan Nine Yards 2007

Butterscotch, spicy cloves, lemon/lime and orange peel with complex mineral citrus flavors. A rich mouth feel and subtly balanced toasty French oak integrate with the long, tropical peach and melon finish.

12. Hamilton Russell Chardonnay 2006

Wonderfully expressive mineral-and-toast bouquet; bright fruit and fine thread of citrus evoking Burgundy's Puligny-Montrachet. Complex, long and very impressive.

Riesling

13. Hartenberg Weisser Riesling 2006

The spicy richness on the nose gives way to a taut yet floral and fruity mid-palate that has both richness and complexity.

14. Buitenverwachting Rhine Riesling 2006

This wine shows typical Riesling character with fruit salad and spicy fragrance on the nose and a fresh acidity, rich mouth feel and minerally palate.

15. Paul Cluver Weisser Riesling 2008

Light yellow in colour with lots of spice and floral notes on the nose. The palate is elegant and rich with a long length which is carried by the acidity of the wine, typical for the varieties.

Chenin Blanc

16. Villiera Chenin Blanc 2007

The wine has intense fruit with a hint of wood spice on the nose, including pineapple, guava and citrus. On the palate it is rich and full bodied with good balance and a long finish.

17. Spice Route Chenin Blanc 2007

Highlighting the best of fully mature bush vines, this wine shows richness, with a lovely round palate, balanced with good grip and a long finish.

18. Beaumont Chenin Blanc 2008

A fresh vibrant palate with a gentle acid balance accompanied by sweet ripe fruit. A silky soft texture with good length at the finish

Viognier

19. Elgin Vinters Viognier 2007

Displays yellow peaches, apricots and kiwi fruit, a food wine which will compliment spicy food.

White Blends

20. Buitenverwachting Buiten Blanc 2006 (Sauvignon, Chenin, Rhine Riesling and Pinot Gris)

A dry, fruity and spicy dry wine with a floral and guava nose.

Rosé and Blanc de Noir

21. Elgin Vintners Rosé 2008

A wine with multi-layered complexity of strawberries and red berries with a lingering after taste.

22. Boschendal Blanc de Noir 2008

A blend of Pinot Noir and Shiraz grapes produces the lovely salmon colour that compliments this wine. This wine displays perfume and flavours of ripe fruit, including red cheery and strawberry.

23. Fairview Rosé 2009

Packed with summer fruit and a wide range of berry flavours.

French White Wines

24. Chateau de Sancerre 2004

Plump, with grapefruit peel, white peach, lime and floral notes. Lovely flavours.

25. Louis Latour Chablis 2006

A bright pale gold colour with a hint of green. The nose is round and rich with intense fresh fruit aromas balanced by a mineral steeliness. This is classic Chablis, medium-bodied with a good crisp finish and pronounced ripe fruit characteristics

RED WINES

26. Hartenberg Cabernet Sauvignon Shiraz 2005

This Cabernet Sauvignon Shiraz blend has an intense fruit flavour, full of vigour with a soft, smooth and silky finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon

27. Darling Cellars Cabernet Sauvignon "Terra Hutton" 2008

After maturation in French oak, the wine becomes full-bodied, with characteristics of ripe forest fruit, cassis and blackcurrant.

28. Springfield Cabernet Sauvignon 2005

Whole Berry maceration is followed by fermentation with natural yeasts, racking and one year's maturation in oak barrels. The result is a velvety wine with softer tannins and classical varietals characteristics.

29. Darling Cellars Onyx Cabernet Sauvignon 2007

An example of pure Cabernet Sauvignon fruit, with hints of blackberries, currants and chocolate flavours. Firm tannins give this wine a solid palate, which are supported by vanilla and wood aromas.

30. Vergelegen Cabernet Sauvignon 2001

A superb example of this variety with cassis, blackcurrants and vanilla on the nose which follow through supported by big ripe tannins which give the wine real structure.

31. Rust en Vrede Cabernet Sauvignon 2004

Intense red colour. Blackberry, red currant and mint aromas with a touch of eucalyptus. The aroma reverberates on the palate, where some dry character also shows. Long fresh finish.

Merlot

32. Darling Cellars Merlot "Six Tonner" 2008

A generously juicy wine with soft tannins, a mulberry fruitiness and hints of mocha on the nose.

33. Slowine Merlot 2006

A multi-faceted wine with hints of chocolate, violets and ripe raspberry. Soft, juicy dark and red berry fruit and tannins provide a long lingering finish.

34. Fairview Merlot 2008

A great depth of fruit with subtle spice notes. Moderate oaking add structure to the wine while allowing the fruit flavours to come to the fore.

35. Laibach Merlot 2007

Chocolate, with hints of toast and dried prunes. Great depth in flavour with classy oak supporting a good mid palette structure. Well balanced, with juicy red berries ending in a medium length finish.

36. Hartenberg Merlot 2006

Ruby red in colour. Supple and fleshy aromas of violets, coffee, chocolate which follow through to the round palate. The finish is long and extremely well balanced.

Pinotage

37. Darling Cellars Old Block Pinotage 2005

An elegant, cool climate Pinotage with a touch of oak. Some spice on the nose as well as an abundance of small red currant fruit.

38. Beyerskloof Pinotage 2007

A full bodied Pinotage with a deep red color. A complex wine with red berry and plum fruit flavors that are well integrated with the oak aromas.

39. Fairvalley Pinotage 2007

Vibrant purple red in colour offering spicy black fruit, with ripe soft tannins and opulent fruit. Dark cocoa and plum flavours, with briary tannins and a tangy, mineral finish. Needs some hearty fare.

40. L'Avenir Pinotage 2006

Intense nose of coffee, black fruit and spice. Rich flavour of plums, blackberry, cherry and dried banana is complemented by nice smooth tannins and a long finish.

41. Southern Right Pinotage 2006

This is a big, full flavoured Pinotage that combines well with other big flavours like spicy foods and red sauces. A ripe voluptuous wine with concentrated dark berry fruit and wood spice.

Shiraz

42. Darling Cellars Black Granite Shiraz 2008

This stunning Shiraz shows great complexity with smoky black olives, ripe fruit and chocolate on the nose with a rich full palate and mouth filling finish.

43. Glen Carlou Syrah 2005

Ruby red with purple hue. Aromas of blackberries, mulberries, toasty oak with a hint of spice on the nose. Rich fruit-driven flavours on the palate with full, round mouth feel. Complex and powerful on the finish.

Pinot Noir

44. De Wetshof Nature in Concert Pinot Noir 2007

The soft, velvety cherry and redcurrant flavours on the nose of this Pinot Noir linger on the palate. Smooth tannins and added dimension through careful oak maturation makes this an elegant wine.

45. Paul Cluver Pinot Noir 2006

This wine has excellent colour with lots of wild berry flavour on the nose. Complemented by touches of chocolate, violet and coffee aromas.

Red Blends

46. Darling Cellars Onyx Kroon 2004

Only the best grapes are used for this small production of Darling Cellar's flagship wine. Spicy notes on the nose with lots of supporting fruit.

47. Glen Carlou Grande Classique 2004

A classic Bordeaux blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Malbec and Petit Verdot. Intriguing aromas of clove, sandalwood and fresh blackcurrant are followed by a velvety smooth palate brimming with ripe berry fruit and well supported by supple tannins and gentle oak.

48. Tokara Red 2003

Melange of aromas, which include cassis, black cherry and mulberry fruits. The palate is dry and firm yet a silky mouth feel prevails with an underlying grip and tannin structure. Traces of brambly fruit and cigar box keep things interesting.

49. Elgin Vintners Agama 2005

A Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot blend conjuring up aromas of caramel and cinnamon with plums, blackberries and cassis.

50. Overgaauw Tria Corda 2001 (Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Malbec)

Velvety choc-slayered black cherry flavours with whiffs of pepper and mint aromas.

51. Warwick Trilogy 2004 (Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc)

Showing a wonderful intensity of fruit and warm mocha flavours, this wine has a sweet, perfumed luscious nose, which is earthy and provocative. Raspberry and blackberry flavours abound.

52. Warwick Three Cape Ladies 2004 (Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Pinotage)

An explosion of fruit on the nose, which is largely attributable to the Pinotage component of the "Cape Blend". The Pinotage is soft and sweet while the Merlot offers a subtle spiciness. Full on the palate with a sweetness on the finish.

53. Creation Syrah Grenache 2007

A full bodied Rhone-style blend rewarding with intense flavours of ripe plum, black pepper and the smokiness characteristic of Syrah.

54. Meinert Synchronicity 2001 (Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Pinotage)

Classical wild berry, cedar and cigar aromas are well supported by sweeter, plummy, mulberry whiffs. A big, rich wine that nevertheless already has a silky, velvety mouth feel and despite its power retains a fine and elegant core.

55. Rupert & Rothschild Baron Edmond 2001 (Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon)

Opulent, rich, blackberry, plum and spicy tobacco flavours with beautifully integrated cedar wood. Classic fruit flavours leave a velvety sensation on the palate.

56. Vergelegen Vergelegen 2002

Cape Bordeaux-style blend showing its class in immaculate fruit, alluring texture, suave tannins. Fine cassis fruit lurking happily in velvet depths of darkly bright fruit.

57. Anwilka 2006

Deep ruby at core, with fresh, youthful ruby rim. Abundant blackcurrant & blackberry fruit aromas with exotic spiciness. Wine critic Robert Parker rated the debut 2005 vintage the finest South African red wine he's tasted.

58. Meerlust Rubicon 1996 (Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc)

On the nose the wine has complex blackberry, dark cherry, cigar box, tobacco leaf and cloves. The wine has great concentration, superb balance and an extraordinary long finish.

Port

59. Landskroon Port

Ripe plums and blackberries make up the bouquet of this port, with a smooth but lively palate and an attractive dry finish.

Dessert Wine

60. Beaumont Goutte d 'Or 1999

Colour is rich golden with glints of green. A nose of concentrated dried fruits, raisins, honey and toasted tones. The palate has a voluptuous viscous feel of honey, apricots and spice finishing clean and citrusy.

Sparkling Wine

61. Graham Beck Brut

Methode Cap Classique produced from Chardonnay and Pinot Noir in a 50/50 blend. The wine remains on the lees in the bottle for a minimum of 24 months before degorgement and another 3 months on the cork before release.

62. Graham Beck Brut Blanc de Blanc 1999

Rich yeasty aromas with hints of clean lime fruit on the nose. A fine mousse and creamy complexity on the palate with an elegant long finish.

Champagne

63. Mumm Cordon Rouge

A fresh golden yellow with jade tints, an elegant stream of bubbles rising to form a rich, lively foam. The nose develops aromas of lemon and grapefruit, with notes of white peach, apricot and acidulous apple. Lingering notes of vanilla, dried fruit and honey.

64. Perrier Jouet Grand Brut

Fresh and lively with spiralling bubbles, delicate bouquet, and a subtle complex flavours. Serve for all occasions, hors d'oeuvres, caviar, seafood dishes with light elegant sauces, or smoked salmon.

65. Moet & Chadron Brut Imperial NV

Brut Impèrial is a complete, generous and dynamic champagne. It is a balanced assemblage of the three wine varieties from the most expressive crus of the Champagne region.

66. Veuve Clicquot

Golden –yellow, with a foaming necklace of tiny bubbles. Initially reminiscent of white fruits and raisins, then vanilla and later of brioche. The lingering aromas echo and re-echo with each fruit or spice note distinct.

67. Bollinger Special Cuvee

Madame Bollinger - "I drink it when I'm happy and when I'm sad. Sometimes I drink it when I'm alone. When I have company I consider it obligatory. I trifle with it if I'm not hungry and drink it when I am. Otherwise I never touch it - unless I'm thirsty."

68. Dom Perignon 1999

The 1999 vintage is praised for its well-orchestrated, precise, and full-bodied taste.
