



## WINE LIST

### HOUSE WINES

#### White Wines

**1. Brampton Sauvignon Blanc 2010**

The inherent Sauvignon Blanc characteristics of gooseberry, lychee, asparagus and passion fruit are sustained on the palate by prodigious length.

**2. Graham Beck The Game Reserve Chenin 2010**

Upfront tropical fruit, ripe pineapple, melon, peaches and honey flavors' on the nose. Full and juicy palate with layers of ripe tropical fruit complemented by a long clean and crisp aftertaste.

#### Red Wines

**3. Brampton OVR 2009** (Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot)

Mouthful wine showing fresh plums and ripe mulberries with a spicy undertone. Carefully blended to achieve a soft, rich fruit driven wine. The perfect all rounder and a must for every wine enthusiast.

**4. Graham Beck The Game Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon 2009**

Notes of blueberries and blackberries, cedar, spices and leather. The palate is dry with black-fruit flavors, toasty oak and wonderfully integrated tannins.

#### Rosé

**5. False Bay 2010**

A delicately spiced and deliciously fruity, dry rose from Cinsault and Mourvedre grapes. A very quaffable, fresh and fruity wine from the famous False Bay vineyards in South Africa

#### Sparkling Wine

**6. Papillon Brut**

Whiffs of peach and grass. Succulent just-dry finish. A light dry blended fruity sparkling wine

#### Port

**7. Landskroon Port 1999**

Ripe plums and blackberries make up the bouquet of this port, with a smooth but lively palate and an attractive dry finish.

## White Wines

### Sauvignon Blanc

#### 8. La Capra Sauvignon Blanc 2011

Classic green pepper aromas, with gooseberries, nettles and green figs. The mouthful shows a lovely balance of palate weight and natural acidity, tempered by a subtle minerality.

#### 9. Darling Cellars Onyx Sauvignon Blanc 2010

An elegant, well structured wine with hints of lime and grapefruit with a light green pepper mouth-feel.

#### 10. Diemersdal Sauvignon Blanc 2012

This vibrant, classically styled Sauvignon Blanc presents a brilliant lemon-lime color. The nose is complex with an array of tropical fruit, ripe figs and gooseberries.

#### 11. Fairview Sauvignon Blanc 2011

Bright and fresh sauvignon blanc with fruit aromas and crispy palate.

#### 12. Spice Route Sauvignon Blanc 2010

Mineral, chalky nose with hints of gooseberry and classic cool climate aromas. Good acid and fruit balance, with lively fruit. Long fresh finish..

#### 13. Mulderbosch Sauvignon Blanc 2010

Pale straw with a lively green colour. A tropical fruit punch nose, packed with granadilla, guava, fig, gooseberry and green pepper – yet maintaining its complex character of grassiness and nettle.

#### 14. Springfield Sauvignon Blanc 2010

This single vineyard originates from the rockiest soil on the Springfield estate, with resultant struggling vines and huge concentration. A dramatic wine full of ripe red peppers and passion fruit.

### Viognier

#### 15. La Capra Viognier 2010

Intense aromas of orange blossom and peach on the nose, with a hint of spice. Rich yet rounded mouth feel is accompanied by fresh fruit flavours and a lingering ginger finish.

#### 16. Fairview Viognier 2010

Displays yellow peaches, apricots and kiwi fruit, a food wine which will compliment spicy food.

#### 17. Spice Routes Viognier 2010

Golden yellow in colour with a greenish tint. Floral nose with hints of spice and ripe peach. Succulent mouth feels with well integrated oak which follows through to a balanced and long finish.

### Chardonnay

#### 18. La Capra Chardonnay 2010

Citrusy and light, with a hint of spice. Apples abound on the palate, softened by a creamy oak texture. Well integrated and balanced with a full mouth feel.

#### 19. Darling Cellars Chardonnay 2010

Citrus, orange blossoms and pineapple are the fruit flavours you'll find on this little gem of a lightly wooded Chardonnay. A clean, soft mouth-feel with lower acidity and pear on the palate.

#### 20. Fairview Chardonnay 2010

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**21. Diemersdal Chardonnay 2012 (unwooded)**

This fashionable wine balances concentrated spicy aromas with fresh fruit flavours. The nose is elegant, with the richness of the fruit enhanced by apple and sweet melon aromas

**22. Hartenberg The Eleanor Chardonnay 2007**

Hartenberg present us their flagship Chardonnay named in honour to Eleanor Finlayson, matriarch of the wine family

**23. Hamilton Russell Chardonnay 2010**

Wonderfully expressive mineral-and-toast bouquet; bright fruit and fine thread of citrus evoking Burgundy's Puligny-Montrachet. Complex, long and very impressive.

## **Chenin Blanc**

**24. La Capra Chenin Blanc 2011**

An aromatic and fruit-filled nose, with a layered palate of apple and pear, hinting at a little oak influence.

**25. Spice Route Chenin Blanc 2011**

Highlighting the best of fully mature bush vines, this wine shows richness, with a lovely round palate, balanced with good grip and a long finish.

**26. Groote Post Chenin Blanc 2011**

A bright, full-styled Chenin with a tropical fruit-salad palate and green apple flavours. A very good length and body for this vintage.

## **Riesling**

**27. Hartenberg Weisser Riesling 2009**

Subtly sweet with typical Riesling aromas – floral, honey and light spice sense – underlined by a hint of soft citrus.

## **Semillon**

**28. Fairview Oom Pagel Semillon 2009**

Pale colour with hints of green gold. The nose reveals the origin of the fruit, with an aroma of fresh herbs, citrus and distinct minerality.

## Red Wines

### Cabernet Sauvignon

#### 29. Darling Cellars Onyx Cabernet Sauvignon 2009

Abundance of ripe cassis with layer of coffee, tobacco, kelp, chocolate and dry tannins. Great to drink alone or with red meat or even matured cheeses.

#### 30. Fairview Cabernet Sauvignon 2010

Classic varietal character with ripe blackcurrant fruit. Rich flavors and ripe apple tannins

#### 31. Vergelegen Cabernet Sauvignon 2001

A superb example of this variety with cassis, blackcurrants and vanilla on the nose which follow through supported by big ripe tannins which give the wine real structure.

### Merlot

#### 32. De Waal Merlot 2008.

Classical full bodied merlot, ripe berry flavours with a hint of mint. Perfect to eat with pasta or roasted meat.

#### 33. Laibach Merlot 2008

Chocolate, with hints of toast and dried prunes. Great depth in flavour with classy oak supporting a good mid palette structure. Well balanced, with juicy red berries ending in a medium finish.

### Pinotage

#### 34. Darling Cellars Old Block Pinotage 2010

An elegant, cool climate Pinotage with a touch of oak. Some spice on the nose as well as an abundance of small red currant fruit.

#### 35. Fairvalley Pinotage 2010

A classic and fruity medium bodied Pinotage.

#### 36. Beyerskloof Pinotage 2010

A full bodied Pinotage with a deep red color. A complex wine with red berry and plum fruit flavors that are well integrated with the oak aromas.

### Shiraz

#### 37. Darling Cellars Black Granite Shiraz 2010

A medium bodied wine displaying wild berries, and ripe plums on the nose.

#### 38. Brampton Shiraz 2008

Matured in oak for 14 months this shiraz has characteristics of cloves, white pepper, black cherries and a hint of dark chocolate

#### 39. First Sighting Shiraz 2008

Versatile full bodied shiraz with a generous ripe fruit. White peppers, mocha and red berries layered with a cool climate spices. Ideal with beef and tomato dishes.

#### 40. Kevin Arnold Shiraz 2008

Standout Cape Rhone-style red from the Waterford Estate, which includes a small portion of Mourvedre. Intoxicating bouquet of spice, lavender & leather; equally fine red-fruited palate reined in by tannins. Excellent.

## Pinot Noir

### 41. First Sighting Pinot Noir 2009

Medium bodied with elegance and finesse, sweet fennel and raspberry combined with spicy oak tannins

### 42. Elgin Pinot Noir 2009

A lovely garnet colour, with lots of wild berry fruit and wild mushroom scents on the nose. The palate is brimming with sweet berry flavours. Long, lingering, velvety finish

## Red Blends

### 43. Darling Cellars Onyx Kroon 2005 (Shiraz, Pinotage, Grenache)

Exceptionally vibrant, fruit driven and a spicy nose with a long juicy finish.

### 44. Groote Post Old Mans Red 2010 (Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc)

A down to earth, easy drinking red which is soft and smooth. Cabernet Sauvignon based, the nose has a faint touch of white pepper and spice with abundant berry and rich plum flavors on the plate

### 45. Vergelegen Mill Race 2007 (Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot)

An appealing nose of plum, mocha and pepper. The flavors of mint, berry and spice are full and lingering, and the tannins are firm but elegant.

### 46. Edgebaston The Berry Box 2009 ( Cabernet Sauvignon, Shiraz, Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Malbec, Petit Verlot)

A medley of small berry and fruit flavours including blackcurrant, raspberry, strawberry, mulberry and blackberry combine with a hint of anise and vanilla to give a wine that is instantly gratifying in flavour.

### 47. Edgebaston The Pepper Box 2010 (Syrah, Mouverdre, Tannat)

Made from grown grapes only in the Stellenbosch region, this wine is created to show the fresh, fruity and spice driven flavours of these Rhone varieties. The colour is youthful and purple/red.

### 48. Fairview Caldera 2008 (Cabernet Sauvignon, Pinotage Merlot)

Cedar, liquorice and black cherry aromas with subtle smokiness. A little shy in its youth, the 2008 Caldera shows elegant, powdery tannins and supple fruit flavours.

### 49. Post House Penny Black 2009 (Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Pinotage, Shiraz)

Stylish finely textured wine. Dark inky black colour. Initial nose of floral petals, also of fynbos, fruitcake, white pepper and hung game. An elegant wine with firm but supple tannins. Rounded ripe fruit giving a long and lingering finish.

## Rosé and Blanc de Noir

### 50. La Capra Rose 2010

Brilliant pink in the glass, with fresh red fruit on the nose. Ripe strawberry and cherry continue on the palate, complemented by crisp acidity and a long, textured finish.

### 51. Diemersdal Sauvignon Rosé 2011

Packed with summer fruit and a wide range of berry flavours.

## INTERNATIONAL WINES

### White Wines

#### **52. Alois Lageder Riff Pinot Grigio 2010 (Italy)**

Riff Pinot Grigio reflects the origin of its prime growing area in style and character, and demonstrates all the varietal's best characteristics: good structure and intensity on the palate, balanced with lively acidity.

#### **53. Dourthe Numero 1 Bordeaux Blanc 2009 (France)**

refreshingly crisp white wine that offers citrus and tropical fruit flavors with very aromatic notes of green chilies, grass, herbs, asparagus and gooseberries commonly contributing to the bouquet

#### **54. Oyster Bay Sauvignon Blanc 2009 (New Zealand)**

This perennial classic New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc has exuberant aromas of gooseberry, grass, cream of asparagus, and melon. It's intense and lively with crisp acidity and a lingering, slightly mineral finish.

#### **55. Moreau et Fies Chablis 2009 (France)**

This Chablis is not aged in oak making it crisp, dry, fruity and with a steely finish.

#### **56. Pascal Jolivet Sancerre 2006 (France)**

Pale, whitish straw in color. The nose is very fresh, very clean with notes of lime peel, green herbs, and black currant; typical, not aggressive.

#### **57. Pascal Jolivet Pouilly-Fumé 2009 (France)**

Pale straw in color. Piquant, mineral, austere, and very clean nose. The palate is open, fresh, and direct, with ripe fruit flavor. Clean biting finish; very youthful; mineral flavors resurface

### Red Wines

#### **58. Valdivieso Malbec 2009 (Chile)**

A midseason ripener, it can bring very deep color, ample tannin, and a particular plum-like flavor component to add complexity to claret blends.

#### **59. Mathelin Beaujolais – Villages Chateau Gaillard 2009(France)**

Young, fruity, invigorating wine from the best of the villages in the region - loads of character and raspberry flavour

#### **60. Ruffino Chianti 2009 (Italy)**

This Chianti features a deliciously vinous bouquet, where the floral and fruity notes lead towards a finish of slightly spicy scents of white pepper and hazelnuts.

#### **61. Dourthe Numero 1 Bordeaux Rouge 2008 (France)**

A rich, tropical fruit and white currant-flavored wine. There is some green plum, fresh acidity and a hint of wood

#### **62. Marques de Caceres Rioja Tinto Crianza 2007 (Spain)**

Bright ruby red in appearance, the nose is dominated by aromas of raspberry, dark plum, cinnamon and vanilla. Round and balanced on the palate with silky tannins and a soft, red-fruited finish.

#### **63. Chateau Eglise d'Armens St. Emillion Grand Cru 2007 (France)**

This medium bodied red wine is firm and concentrated with toasty, smoky aromas and flavours centered around a core of cherry flavour

## Sparkling Wine

### 64. Graham Beck Brut Rose

Methode Cap Classique. Pale silver pink. Aromas of raspberries and cherries.

### 65. Graham Beck Brut

Methode Cap Classique produced from Chardonnay and Pinot Noir in a 50/50 blend.

### 66. Graham Beck Brut Blanc de Blanc 1999

Rich yeasty aromas with hints of clean lime fruit on the nose. A fine mousse and creamy complexity on the palate with an elegant long finish.

## Champagne

### 67. Mumm Cordon Rouge

A fresh golden yellow with jade tints, an elegant stream of bubbles rising to form a rich, lively foam. The nose develops aromas of lemon and grapefruit, with notes of white peach, apricot and acidulous apple. Lingering notes of vanilla, dried fruit and honey.

### 68. Moët & Chandon Brut Imperial NV

Brut Impèrial is a complete, generous and dynamic champagne. It is a balanced assemblage of the three wine varieties from the most expressive crus of the Champagne region.

### 69. Bollinger Special Cuvee

Madame Bollinger - "I drink it when I'm happy and when I'm sad. Sometimes I drink it when I'm alone. When I have company I consider it obligatory. I trifle with it if I'm not hungry and drink it when I am. Otherwise I never touch it - unless I'm thirsty."

### 70. Perrier Jouet Grand Brut

Fresh and lively with spiraling bubbles, delicate bouquet, and a subtle complex flavours. Serve for all occasions, hors d'oeuvres, caviar, seafood dishes with light elegant sauces, or smoked salmon.

### 71. Dom Perignon 1999

The 1999 vintage is praised for its well-orchestrated, precise, and full-bodied taste.
